Esplanade Ave., left turn on Esplanade to N. Claiborne Ave.,
right on N. Claiborne to St. Bernard, right on St. Bernard,
right onto St. Claude/N. Rampart, back to Armstrong Park;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the parties will retain all rights to litigate any further issues that may arise in this

matter, including attorneys fees and costs.
