
IT IS ORDERED that Plaintiffs will be issued a permit for a parade on February 4, 2008, beginning at 1 p.m., and to traverse the following route:

Begin at Armstrong Park. Follow N. Rampart Street to Esplanade Ave., left turn on Esplanade to N. Claiborne Ave., right on N. Claiborne to St. Bernard, right on St. Bernard, right onto St. Claude/N. Rampart, back to Armstrong Park;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the parties will retain all rights to litigate any further issues that may arise in this

matter, including attorneys fees and costs.
