

COVID-19 Plan Re:

Cross Agency Evaluation/Consideration of Certain Inmates for Release onto Supervision/Home Confinement

Background: Due to COVID-19 Pandemic Emergency pertains to potential release of *certain inmates* in DPS&C custody who are within *6 months* of release date and meet *other certain criteria and approved a selection/review panel as outlined below*). The Secretary/DOC may grant temporary release/furlough to persons within 6 months of release date pursuant to statutory authority (LA. R.S. 15:833C). DOC may add additional eligibility/suitability criteria and delineate a process and conditions for such temp releases/furloughs.

Law enforcement stakeholders (LDAA and LSA) have vocalized their position to the Governor and to the Department of Corrections that any releases pursuant to COVID-19 response **must be done on an** individual basis not on a general group classification. The below process was crafted with the utmost interest of public safety and not only limits the baseline eligibility criteria for consideration to only those inmates who are serving a conviction for a nonviolent/non-sex offense and within 6 months prior to release/served six months or have high risk medical condition but also provides a second layer for a case by case/individual assessment of each inmate by a 6-member panel. This accomplishes the individual assessment and also involves LSA and LDAA in the review and approval process even though the statutory authority authorizing such furloughs gives sole decision making authority to the Secretary/Department of Corrections. Furthermore, such plan is in accordance with the same considerations being done at the federal level as on March 27, 2020, President Trump signed into law, the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act, or the "CARES Act." Which among other things, broadens the authority of the Attorney General and the Director of the BOP, during the COVID-19 crisis, to release prisoners to home confinement.

Timeline: The general schedule will be as follows: of 40 cases per hearing docket / 3 hearings per week **or** 60 cases per hearing docket/2 hearings per week= total of 120 cases per week. *Exact days of week have not yet been decided although TWT is preferable as indicated by parties.* DOC will prepare digital file per each inmate on the docket for the following week's docket to include info such as (master prison record, rap sheet, disciplinary history, program completion history). *Tentative start date is Tuesday, April 14th.* All parties agree that the priority regarding scheduling timeline (1) is to allocate a reasonable time for pre-review/assessment prior to each panel hearing **AND** (2) to do so in a way that maintains the need for expediency due to the critical nature of the COVID-19 crisis. DOC will assign administrative staff person to panel as well. Hearings conducted Most likely via Zoom or other technology platform. *(All of this subject to modification per the needs of DOC/LSA/LDA).*

LDAA/LSA/DOC Agreed Upon Conditions are as Follows:

Parties agree that (LSA/LDA/DOC) and membership thereof will not publicize such info until Governor JBE officially announces his plan to the public.

(Note DOC will formalize below in form of Department Regulation prior to commencement of hearings).*

I. Which DPS&C Inmates:

Below type(s) of Inmates will be eligible for consideration/review/assessment for suitability to release to home confinement and onto supervision:

1. Inmates with existing medical conditions that increase risk complications/ impact of COVID-19 (if were to be infected) who are within *6 months of release date* **and** serving a sentence for a *non-violent (non-sex)* offense.
 - **Max Possible Impact:** (approx. 100 persons) *Each person must be individually reviewed*
 - **Located:** These are currently housed in only state facilities:
2. Inmates who are currently within *6 months of release date* who are serving a sentence for a *non-violent/non-sex offense*, **and** have served at *least 6 months*

- **Max Possible Impact:** (approx. 1150); *Each person must be individually reviewed*
- **Located:** majority in local jails

Process for Consideration/Review and Required Conditions if Approved (PER EACH INMATE):

1. Require Suitability Assessment and Release Approval Process:

- **COVID-19 Six-member (6) panel and (5/6 approval required)**

- **Members:** (1) Secretary or designee, (2) P&P director or designee, (3) Parole Board Executive Director (4) Victim’s Advocate as appointed by Governor (5) the Executive Director of Pardon and Parole Board or designee (6) LDAA ED or Designee (6) LSA ED or Designee
- **Panel role:** evaluate/vet/assess each pre-determined eligible individual (those inmates listed in above section) on public safety/prior disciplinary history/rap sheet etc. and make decision to approve or deny release onto supervision and home confinement.
- **Duration:** COVID-19 Panel will sunset upon the expiration of Governor JBE COVID-19 Emergency Proclamation.

2. Minimum Required Conditions of Release:

- Must have housing or residence
- Home confinement required
- Ankle Bracelet Monitoring Device
- Abide by federal/state/local laws (standard requirement of parole).
- Monitored by Probation and Parole/Assigned a supervision officer

3. Duration of Temporary Release (if granted): The offender’s temporary release shall terminate on the date of the assigned Good Time Parole Supervision release date, the date of release assigned by the Parole Board, or full term release date, whichever is earlier, at which point transition onto parole supervision (if PE or GTPS date); If full-term release date (no supervision) as sentence completed.

4. Violations/Re-arrests/Parole Holds: Probation and Parole may cancel an offender’s participation in the Program for any violation of conditions placed upon the offender.

- **Per Request of LSA Re Violations/parole holds:**

- Violations of home arrest/ankle bracelet and other technical violations to be housed in a DOC facility if available space otherwise in a local jail with available space. Any offender arrested during the temporary release/home confinement period of sentence for the commission of a new offense that is a sex crime, or a crime involving the use of a firearm, shall be housed in a sheriff’s jail for the standard rate per diem.

5. Data Tracking: DOC will track statistical data on the incidence of furlough violations by participating inmates. Violations shall include the commission of new offenses as well as any transgressions that result in disciplinary action or removal from the program etc.

- 1) Attached is Norris interview with WWNO which captures the DOC meeting in his own words
- 2) Below are my own notes which DOC has not had a chance to review and comment on... so they are not in stone and some items are still being worked through and clarified.

Here are Ryan Haynie's notes from the call 3/31 with Norris, Sec. Leblanc, Ryan and Natalie Laborde. Mostly Norris and the Sec speaking. I did my best to make notes and all of this is subject to changes and simply my understanding and remembrance of the call.

Great conversation between Norris and Sec. Leblanc. DOC gave commitment to get back on Zoom or on the phone anytime. Ryan and Natalie will continue daily conversation. DOC is giving recommendations to Governor office this week on action he can/should take on releases. As soon as the recommendations are sent to the Gov office I will set a call with them. DOC is working on getting Gov. press office approval to get the DOC website to be updated with more information on their processes and a FAQ for family members. The Governor has this as a priority and as put top staff on making sure it gets the attention it deserves.

Camp J – The Sec. explained to us that Angola really is the safest and best available location to move COVID- patients if there is not ability to keep local prison populations from being infected. It would be totally quarantined and separate in all aspects from the general population. The plan is to staff it with totally separate nursing staff from DOC HQ (they have 24 DOC nurses available to provide the care) and that the corrections staff will be Pardon and Parole and not Angola staff. No inmate will be used to assist the quarantine unit at camp J. Norris did recommend standing up a facility on open property of the facility if it comes to that. They said that Allen is not an ideal place to host a contingency quarantine. That Angola under the right plan is the safest and first option. Current population at DOC facilities are already being separated to keep the elderly, dialysis and most vulnerable away from risks and giving them more social distancing and changed the way these groups are fed and given medical. Angola (and likely other DOC facilities) are starting to manufacture personal protection devices for inmates. Sec said that they think the inmates can make 1000 masks as week (Norris said that they will make a lot more than that since it is for themselves). DOC is procuring as much protection equipment and masks as they can and will at first only have enough to give to staff... but that is key because that is whom would possibly bring it into the prison. (the science is that the mask is most useful to stop someone with it from giving it to others.. it is only modestly effective of protecting someone from getting it.) They know that if staff starts wearing the gear and not inmates then there will be fear and want to work through how to best educate inmates and avoid a bad reaction. That situation is a work in progress.

There is only one case in a DOC facility. There are 5 confirmed cases in local jails. Two at EBR. One is pretrial and quarantined and one is DOC and is in the hospital. There are also 3 cases at two other prisons. Public information on testing is here:

There are very very few transfers happening now across the state at DOC and Jails. Only on emergency and medical basis are they moving people. Any one coming through the admittance center gets quarantined for 14 days before going to general population. Staff is being turned away if any reason to think they are not well or have been at risk. Work release has been cut in half to only folks doing essential business (often related to response). Should have a phone bank set up within days (help inmates connect with family) ... should have video visit capabilities set up ASAP for inmates but talking at least a week or two to get up and operational.

Norris spoke a lot about the fear of the inmates and their loved ones on the outside. And the discussion was had on how to take the edge off of the uncertainty out there. They are looking at the population and trying to determine whom can be released under a number of mechanisms (6 month out furlough, medical parole, restoration of lost good time, our of parish warrants, probation/parole holds). Again these recommendations should be to the Governor this week hopefully today. Part of the concern is that people need a place to go when they get released and also that some releases require 60 day victim notification. Also looking into if they can do some home confinement through ankle bracelets and what FEMA may pay for. Norris offered to help provide and raise funds for any of that. This is all work in progress.

At the end Norris asked the Secretary if he would join us in asking the governor to act on the

commutations on his desk and making these other releases happen. The Secretary said he would be making recommendations and is on the same page as Norris that it goes a very very long way to protect inmates and creates a much better moral in the facilities even if folks are not getting immediately released. Creates hope. We have access to talk to the Secretary as often as needed and Ryan will communicate with Natalie on a as needed bases no less than weekly but more likely daily as the situation progresses.

The general schedule would be as follows: **40 cases per hearing docket** / 3 hearings per week on MWF/ total of 120 cases per week. Friday prior drop box would upload docket list for the the next week with folder per each inmate to include the following info (master prison record, rap sheet, prison

disciplinary history, Tiger Risk Score, and Accomplishment/Program history list). This would allow for a total of 4 days review time per week: Saturday/Sunday/Tuesday/Thursday. First Panel would convene Monday, April 13th. We believe this is reasonable time and also maintains the need for expedited review given the critical nature and urgency of the COVID-19 crisis. DOC will assign administrative staff person to panel as well. Hearings conducted Most likely via Zoom or other technology platform.

3. Re Violations/parole holds etc: (rec 3, 4,5)

As stated during the Governor's news conference Tuesday, the meetings will be conducted via video, and these meetings will not be open to the public.

- How do inmates who believe they're eligible apply for consideration?

The Department of Corrections has done a thorough review and compiled a comprehensive list of inmates who meet the criteria for consideration of being a nonviolent/non-sex offender within six months of release.

- How will the panel decide which cases to review first? Are they being prioritized somehow?

The COVID-19 Furlough Review Panel will consider first the individuals in group one who have pre-existing medical conditions. ????????????????

- Is there any possible relief mechanism for inmates who are violent offenders or nonviolent but not within six months of their release date (and therefore don't meet the criteria for medical furlough) but have severe chronic medical conditions?

In order to be considered, the individuals must meet the criteria spelled out in Tuesday's news release which includes being a nonviolent/non-sex offender within six months of release.

Thank you for your assistance during the COVID-19 pandemic crisis with many issues concerning the correctional population and our pre-trial detainees.

As Sheriffs, the safety of our law-abiding citizens is our foremost concern. We have a firmly established belief that a sentenced and convicted individual should "do their time." However, with an understanding that the State needs to plan for what could be a life-time event with implications of severe human tragedy, we have responded with suggestions to your recommendations for the process of the furlough of state offenders. We understand the matter rests entirely with the authority of the Secretary by statute.

Our concerns on the proposal are as follows:

Concerning the issue pertaining to the early release of offenders in Group 1, whereby medical conditions which would increase the risk complications of COVID-19 (if infected) who are within six months of release date, we believe to be a solid measure within both correctional and medical standards.

However, the draft concerning the early release of offenders in Group 2 who have served a minimum of six months and who are within six months of their release dates does cause concerns to us, even though non-violent and non-sex offenders have been specified.

We realize again that you may proceed regardless of our concerns, but we urge your consideration of the revisions below.

Recommendation 1: Concerning the Panel

- a) Remove one of the four DOC positions on the panel and replace with a victims' advocate.
- b) Assert that a quorum should be five of the six
- c) The membership of the panel shall be 3 members of the DOC structure appointed by the Secretary, a victims' advocate appointed by the Governor, the LDAA representative, the LSA representative.

We believe this membership provides balance and keeps the suggested requirement of 4/5 or 4/6 approval.

Recommendation 2: Caseload

Meetings must have a reasonable caseload whereby proper vetting can be achieved. No more than 30 cases per meeting. All information for the process to be supplied by DOC from existing

records sources and strictly adhere to the specifications of the "panel role" as specified in the proposed document.

Recommendation 3: Home Incarceration/Ankle Bracelets

Violations of home arrest/ankle bracelet and other technical violations to be housed in a DOC facility. (We should illustrate serious sanctions for those non-compliant offenders.)

Recommendation 4: Re-Arrest-Serious Charges

For offenders who are re-arrested during the confinement period of sentence for the commission of a violent offense or a sex crime, or a crime involving the use of a firearm, shall be held in a sheriff's jail for the standard rate per diem.

Recommendation 5: Re-Arrest-Other Charges

All other re-arrests shall be considered parole-holds, without the 14-day processing period by DOC.

We don't want to dis-mantle what could turn out to be a necessary component of dealing with the COVID-19 pandemic crisis. However, our broad statement is of deep concern that following the crisis, what impact these early releases will have on the criminal justice system. The same tracking of offenders specified in the re-investment program for determining the rate of recidivism should be a mandatory provision adopted by the DOC for later review. Furthermore, once this pandemic event has concluded, we believe there should be a sunset provision pertaining to the termination of the work of the panel.

LSA INQUIRIES/ REQUESTS FOR PANEL MEETINGS

1. What DOC staff will be there to answer questions? We specifically request that a medical staffer be there to answer questions that may arise about the offender's condition.
2. Is it possible to do this in a large room but very spread apart? (Sheriff Champagne asked/made this suggestion - said he would be willing to come if needed.)
3. The disciplinary records are not in the files. Sheriffs will ask if the disciplinary record is complete -- this is key information. Will disciplinary records be included in the future? Is anything being done to gather info from local level for the Governor's review?
4. We know these offenders with early release will be on ankle monitoring... How does DOC plan to enforce violations? And exactly what are the specific restrictions for an

offender who is released early on ankle monitoring?

5. Is DOC going to use the same format and procedures as they do for regular pre-release? Or will they be different for these furloughs?

6. We need a "pre-parole investigation" to review at the time of the hearing. (The summary of the actual crime the offender is serving time for would be very helpful in the evaluation process).

7. We also need institutional progress reports that are prepared by the facilities (some if not all of this info may already be provided, but we need to make sure).

8. In addition, we need a mental health assessment on all listed offenders in the state prisons. (Sheriff Travis stated that DOC has this on all offenders in state custody.)

9. We request that the Warden of the facility that the offender is housed in be available on Zoom to make comments or answer questions about the offender being reviewed.

(This is currently how it's done with the Parole Board. No one is in a better position to answer questions about the conduct of an offender better than the jail staff. It may also help in getting disciplinary information once we reach the local level.)

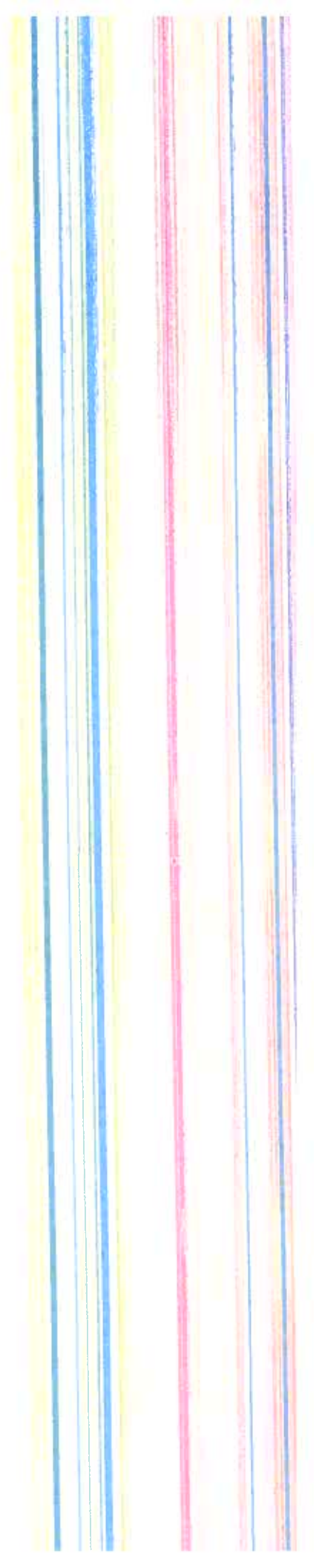

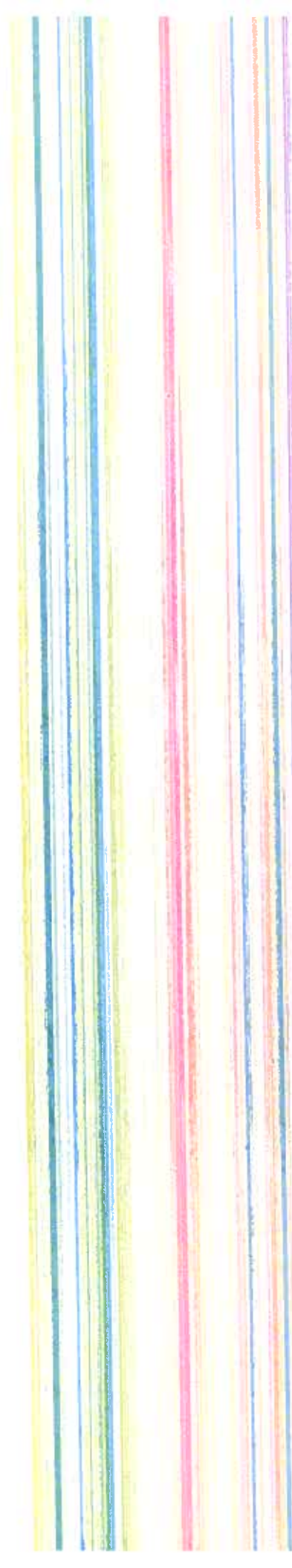
